

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS NEXUS TRIPLE SLEEPER

IMPORTANT - READ CAREFULLY - RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

HEALTH & SAFETY

DO NOT jump on this bed frame.

WARNING: **DO NOT** use the bunk bed / high bed if any structural part is broken or missing.

DO NOT use this bed frame unless all fixings are secured.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.

Always use on a level, even surface.

WARNING: High beds and the upper bed of bunk beds are not suitable for children under six years due to the risk of injury from falls.

This bed frame complies to BS EN 747-1&2:2012 + A1:2015

Always follow the manufacturer's instructions.

WARNING: Bunk beds and high beds can present a serious risk of injury from strangulation if not used correctly.

Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed to be used with the bed, for example, but not limited to ropes, strings, cords, hooks, belts and bags.

WARNING: Children can become trapped between the bed and the wall, a roof pitch, the ceiling, adjoining pieces of furniture (e.g. cupboards) and the like. To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrier and the adjoining structure shall not exceed 75mm or shall be more than 230mm.

WARNING: If this bed placed on a non-carpeted floor you must place some protection under all legs to stop the bed from moving. If this is not adhered to there is no guarantee if the bed frame collapses.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Assemble in the room of use.

Periodically check all screws & fixings to ensure they are secure.

DO NOT push the bed frame as this will damage the legs.

Always lift the bed with two people to reposition.

Keep any sharp objects away from the frame.

Recommended size of mattress for top bunk is 914 x 1900mm.

Recommended size of mattress for bottom bunk is 1372 x 1900mm.

Sticker marking the mattress maximum thickness can be found on the headboard post and mattress being used do not exceed the arrow on the sticker.

Recommended maximum mattress height for top bunk is 200mm.

Ventilation of the room is necessary in order to keep the humidity low and to prevent mold in and around the bed.

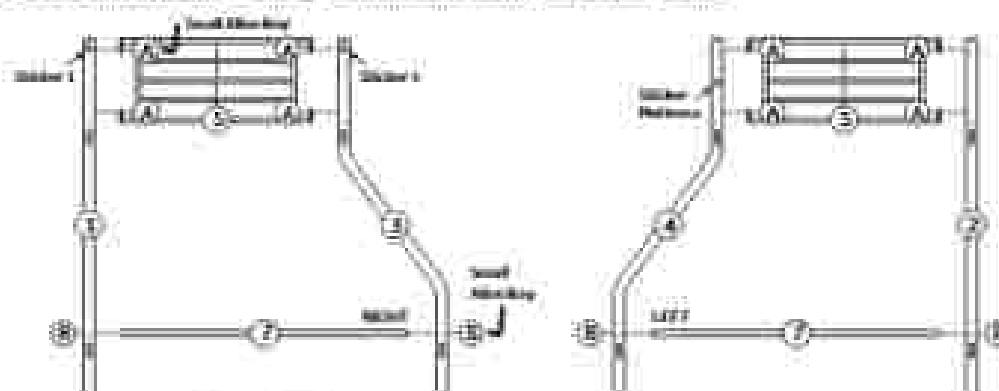

STEP 1 : Fit the Headend Frame (5) to the Right Post A (1) and Right Post B (3) using hardware part (A), then attach the Frame Support (7) using hardware part (B). Repeat for the left side.

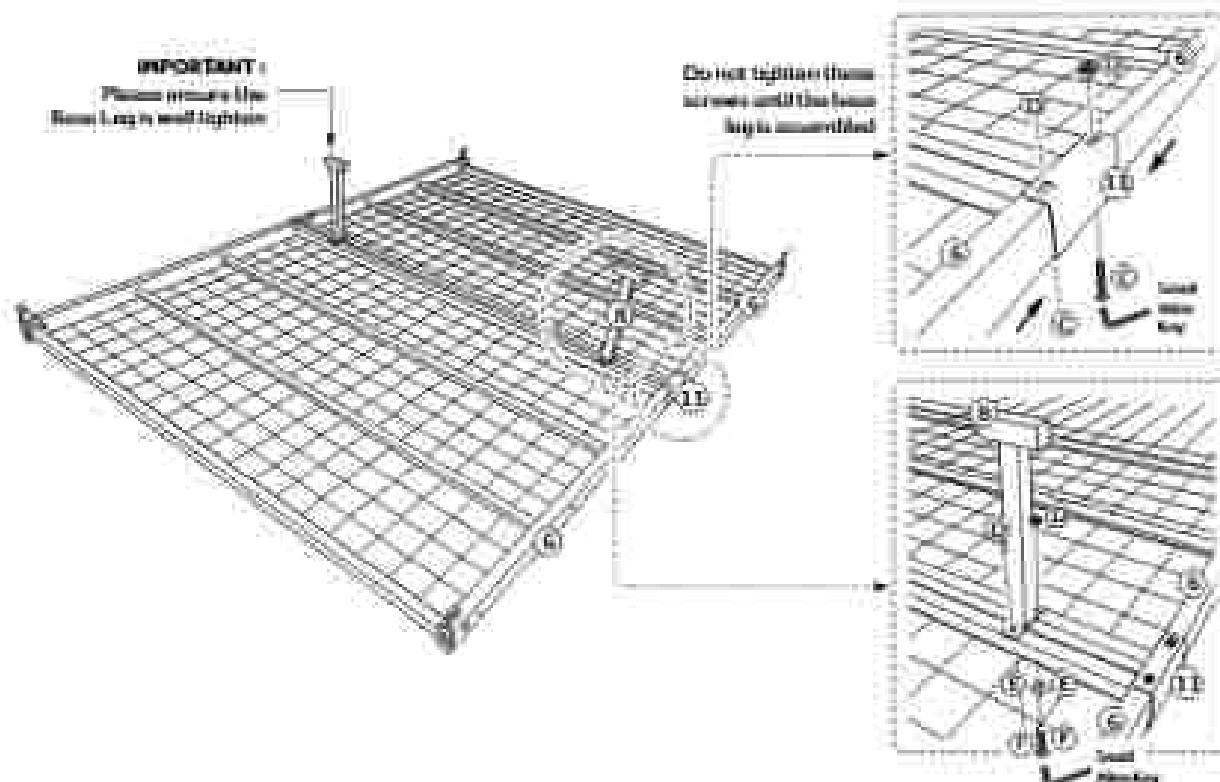
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



IMPORTANT : Please ensure all the screws are being tightened up

STEP 2: Join together the Bottom Base Panels (6) with the Center Support (11) using hardware parts (C) and (D), then attach the Base Legs (8) using hardware parts (E), (F) and (F).

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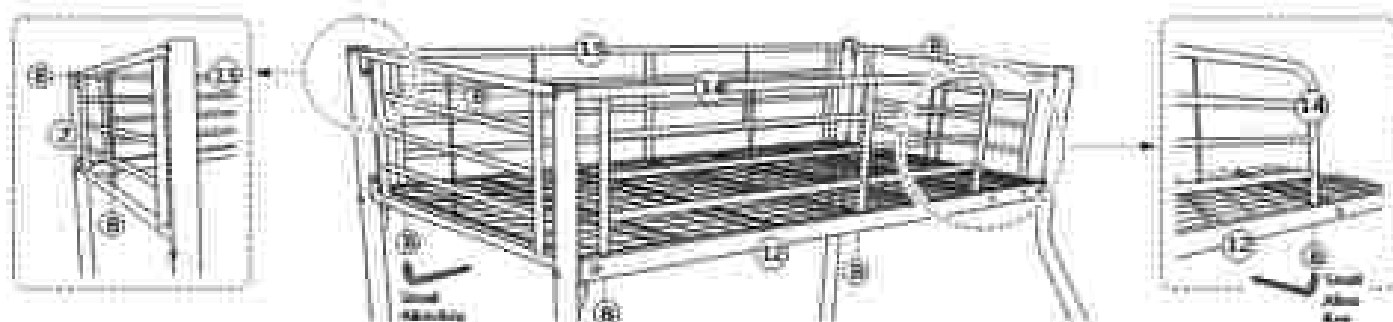


STEP 3: Attach the Top Base (12) and Bottom Base (6) using hardware parts (G) and (H) but do not fully tighten yet.

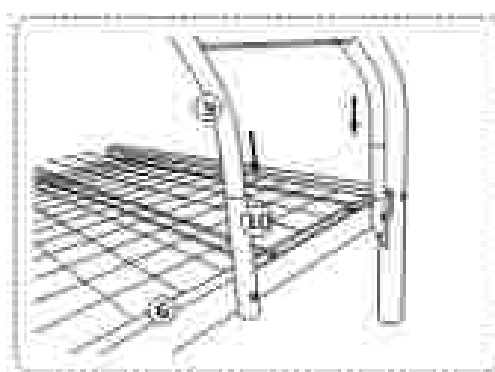
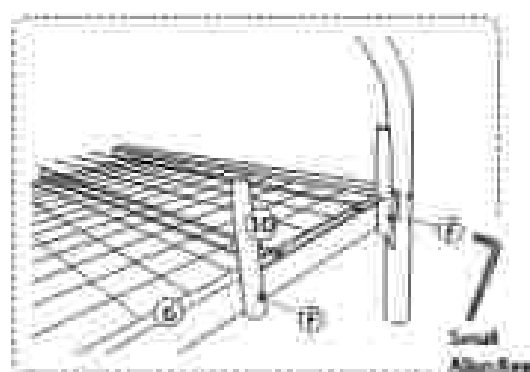
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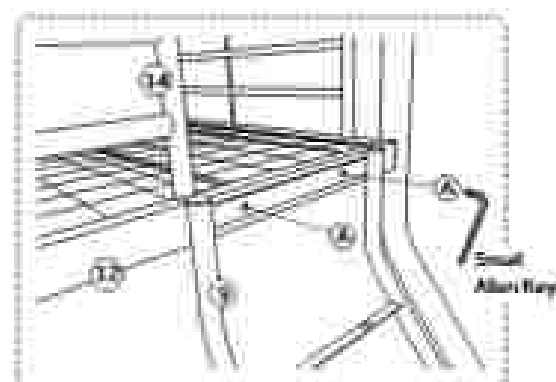
STEP 4: Secure the Back Rail (13) and Front Rail (14) in position using hardware part (B).
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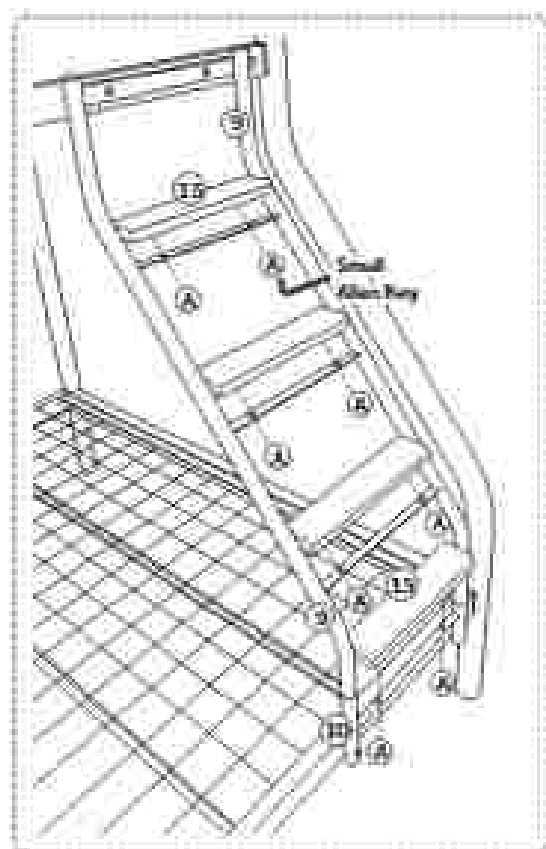
STEP 3: Fit the Ladder Connector (10) to the Bottom Base (6) using hardware part (F), then slot the Ladder (9) into the Ladder Connectors (10).
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STEP 6: Secure the Ladder (9) to the Top Base (12) using hardware parts (A), then attach the Ladder Steps (15) to the Ladder (9) and Ladder Connector (10) using hardware part (A).
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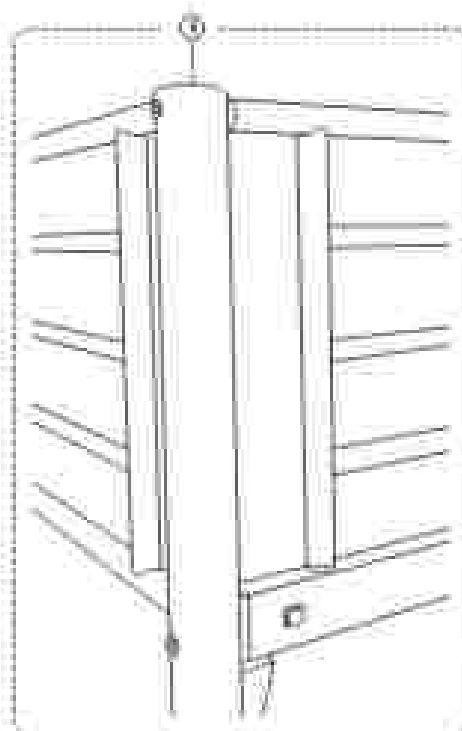


Please use the ladder to access the upper bunk.



STEP 7: Insert hardware part 10 to the bed posts.

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NOTE: PLEASE INSERT THOSE BLACK ROUND STUD (J) INTO THE EXTRA 10MM HOLES
